Hello Everybody

Welcome to the last newsletter of the academic year - I cannot believe we are here already!

This is always one of the busiest times for us as we prepare to welcome our new cohort of Y3 children in September and wish our Y6 children the best of luck as they prepare to move to high school.

For parents that will continue to use our service through the next academic year, please note that your sessions are automatically rolled over. Should you need to amend these please get in touch before <u>19th June 2024</u> so that we can then start to allocate spaces to our new families.

We have already received a lot of booking forms for September, particularly for siblings of children that already attend - please note that these are <u>NOT</u> confirmed until you receive a confirmation email in July/August. Rest assured we do give priority to existing users/siblings.

As a club we have been reviewing our finances, and after discussions with the management committee we have had to make the decision to raise our fees from **September 24**, We have not made this decision lightly, mindful that parents and carers are also under pressure due to the rising cost of living - please see attached letter for further details.

Can we ask that all parents help us out by remembering to let us know if your child isn't attending their booked session by leaving a message on the landline **0114 230 7939**. Please also let us know if your child is joining any of the clubs that the school is offering so that we can account for their whereabouts. In cases where we are expecting a child and cannot contact you, **we will contact the police to inform them a** *child is missing.*

Can we just remind parents that if you need to make a change to your regular sessions to please give us **<u>AT LEAST 4 weeks notice</u>**, we do where we can try and make all of these changes for you, however we do have to consider staffing and ratios which are all done a month in advance in order for us to ensure we have enough staff to meet the demand. We are lucky to be a very busy club, however this does mean that sessions are not always available last minute.

Important information:

- You will be invoiced every half term for your sessions. We aim to send the invoices by the end
 of the first week of each half term, *please note that there will be a separate invoice for breakfast club and ASC*. Payments are to be made by BACS or childcare vouchers. All of
 your sessions continually roll over and will stay the same unless you inform us of any
 changes needed with *at least 4 weeks notice.*
- We are exceptionally busy now within the club which means we cannot guarantee the availability of AD-Hoc sessions. We have legal ratios and limits that we have to adhere to and the safety of our children is paramount. If you require ad-hoc sessions, please where possible get in touch in advance of the sessions you require so that we can look at staffing and see if we can facilitate this.
- Can we ask that all parents help us out by remembering to let us know if your child isn't attending via leaving a message on the landline **0114 230 7939**. Please let us know if your child is attending another club and coming to us afterwards.
- In cases where we are expecting a child and cannot contact you, we will contact the police to inform them a child is missing.
- We are a separate organization from the school, please do not assume we know what the school knows, for example if the children are having friendship problems, we may not be aware and then are unable to offer the best possible care for your child.
